

The DWP aims to act as a catalyst for innovation, knowledge, and best practices around digitalisation for the water industry, provide a platform to share experiences and promote leadership in transitioning to digital water solutions, and consolidate lessons to guide the natural evolution from 'business as usual' to achieving a digital water utility.

The DWP is driven by end users (e.g., utilities and regulators) as well as solution providers (e.g. technology companies, software companies, researchers, and academia) at the forefront of emerging technologies to solve urgent and costly operational problems to deliver water services.

Steering Committee


